# **COVID-19 SPECTATOR CODE**

### IN ADDITION TO GROUND REGULATIONS



Whilst Covid restrictions are being lifted, the Club will continue to take steps to ensure the safety and well-being of all in attendance at our matches.

## **COVID-19 SPECIFIC RISKS**

- 1. Spectators must not attend if they are suffering from Covid-19 symptoms and / or are required to self-isolate.
- 2. Spectators should assess the risk associated with attending, both at the point of ticket purchase, and on the day of the game, relative to their own personal circumstances, age, group size and makeup, health status and susceptibility to infection.
- 3. All spectators agree to adhere to requirements stipulated at the venue regarding the movements and behaviours of spectators, including following the advice to wear face coverings.
- 4. We advise spectators to wear a face covering when moving around the venue, when using the toilet facilities and when queuing for toilets / catering facilities.
- 5. Guidance may be changed and updated at short notice, consistent with the latest Government and Public Health England guidance.
- 6. Please observe respiratory etiquette always cover your mouth if needing to cough or sneeze. Avoid hugs, high-fives and any close contact with people who are not within your social bubble. Take care when celebrating.

# **TICKETS AND ARRIVAL**

- 1. On arrival at the ground please either have your membership card or print at home ticket ready to be scanned on entry. Please respect the personal space of other spectators when queuing and follow the directions of stewards.
- 2. Please use the hand sanitiser stations positioned around the venue and at the entrance seating areas.
- 3. When accessing your seat it may be necessary to "brush past" other spectators in your row. In this case please face away from the other spectator as you pass.

### **SEATING & FACILITIES**

- 1. Please use the hand sanitary stations regularly. Face coverings may be required at times, consistent with the latest Public Health England guidance.
- 2. Catering facilities and bars will be available. Please respect the personal space of other spectators when queuing and please return to your seats to consume food and drinks.
- 3. All catering outlets are cashless. Utensils and containers are all disposables.
- 4. Temporary toilet facilities are situated around the ground. Please respect the personal space of other spectators when queuing and using the hand basins. We would advise spectator to wear face coverings whilst inside the toilet facility.
- 5. Toilets and touch points around the ground will be cleaned regularly to ensure a very high standard of cleanliness.
- 6. At the conclusion of the match, please follow the advice of stewards when leaving your seats.
- 7. Smoking and Vaping is permitted in designated areas only and is prohibited in seating areas.
- 8. All other ground regulations remain in force.
